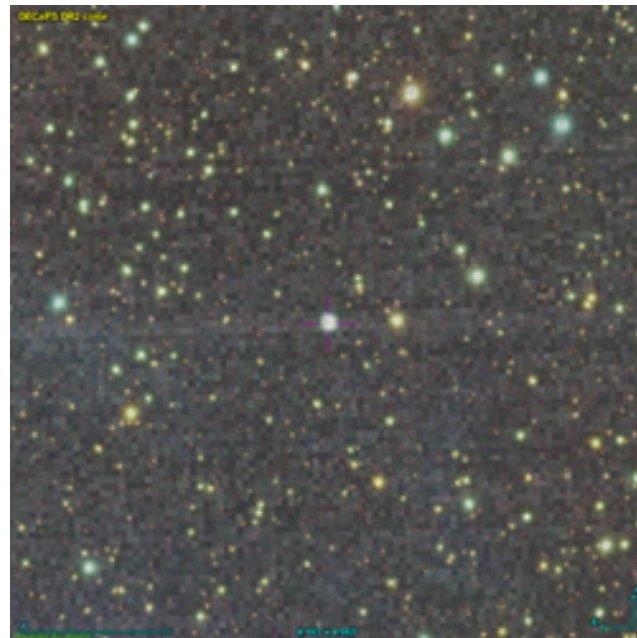

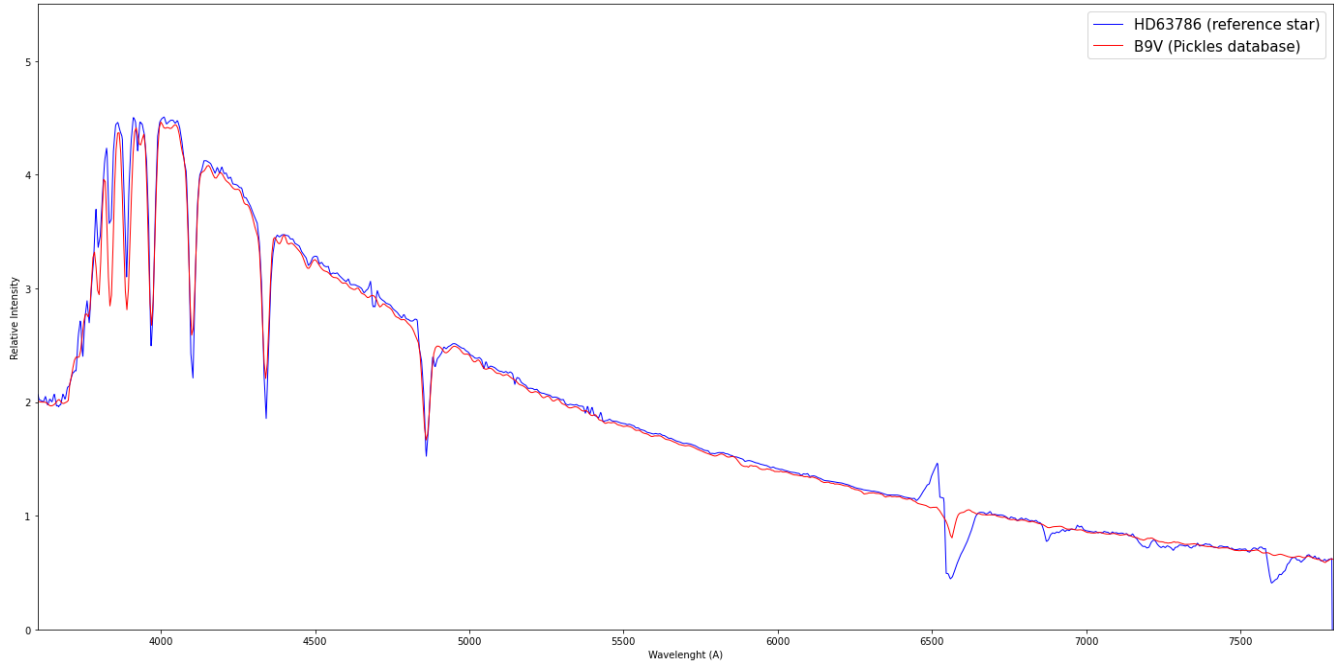

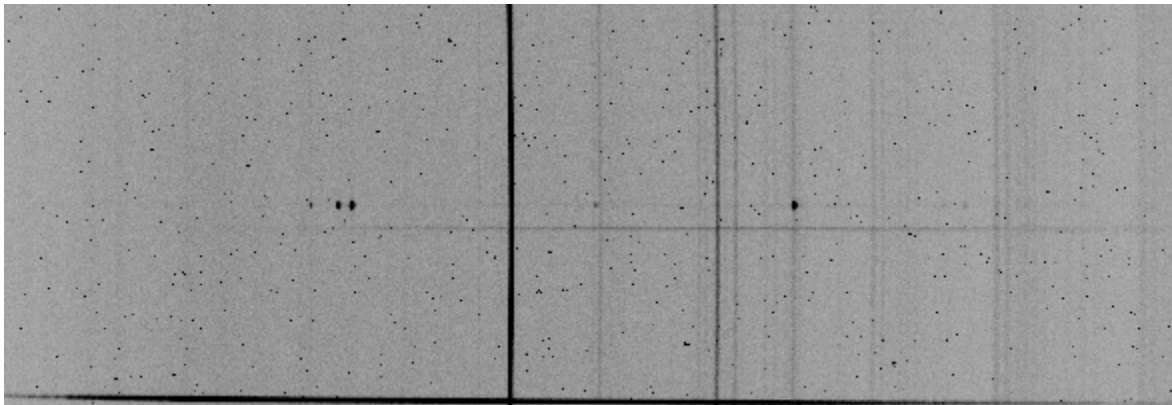


Instrumental Response and 2D Spectra

2D Raw spectrum

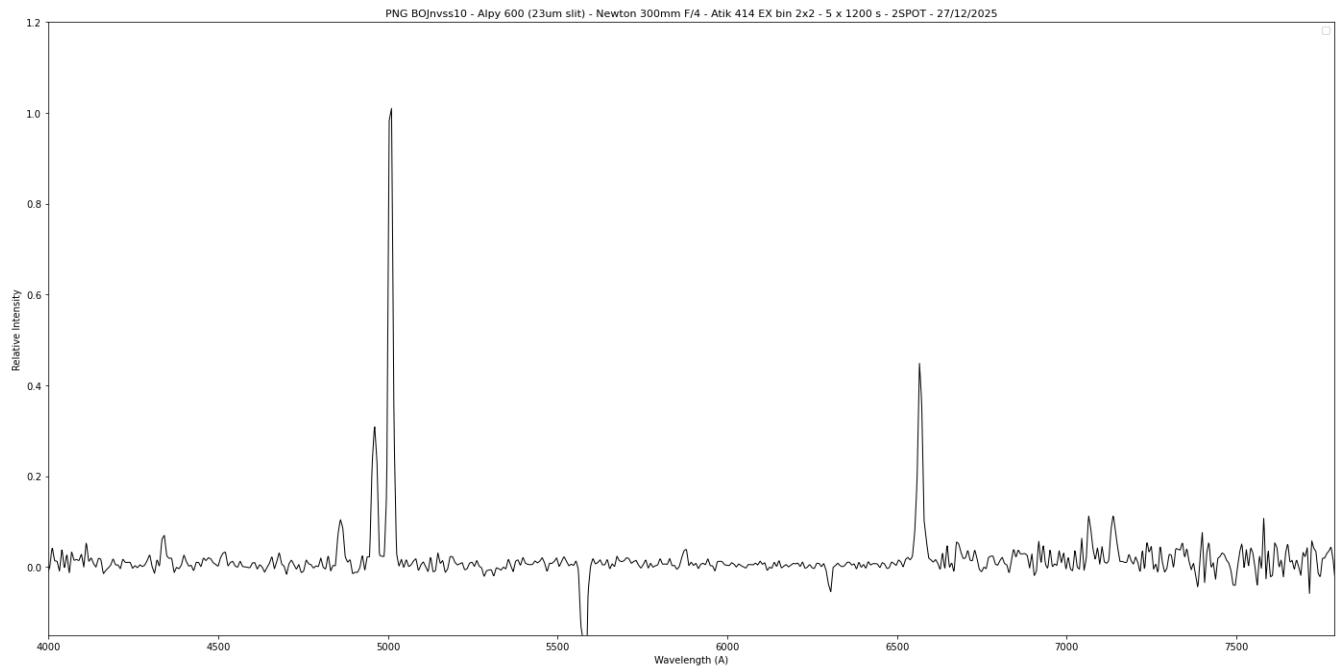


2D Processed spectrum
