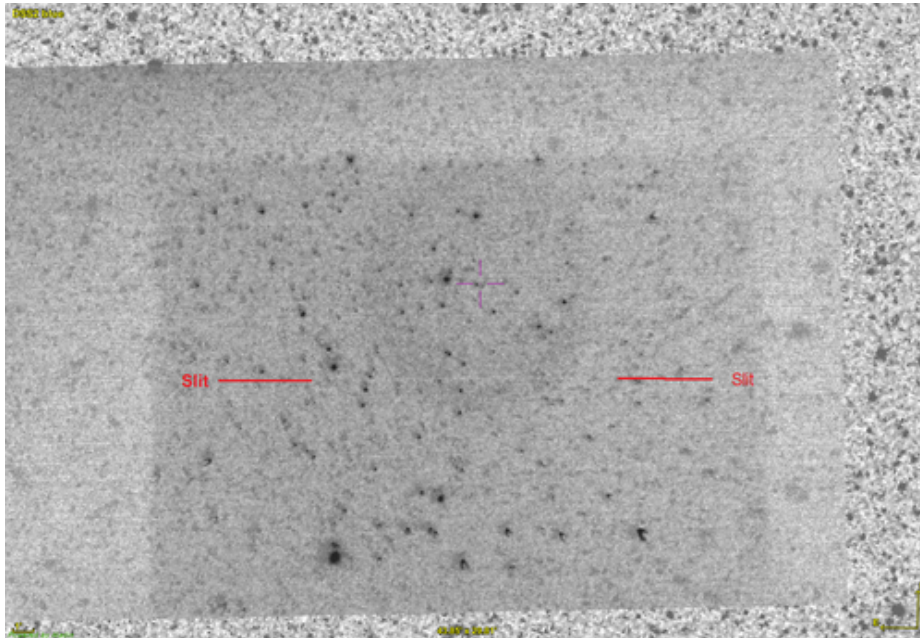

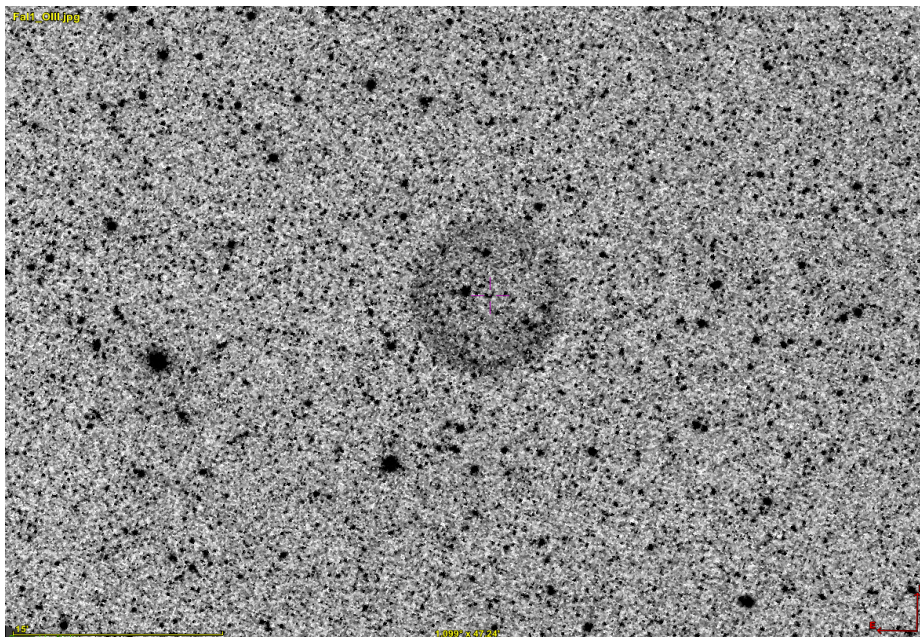

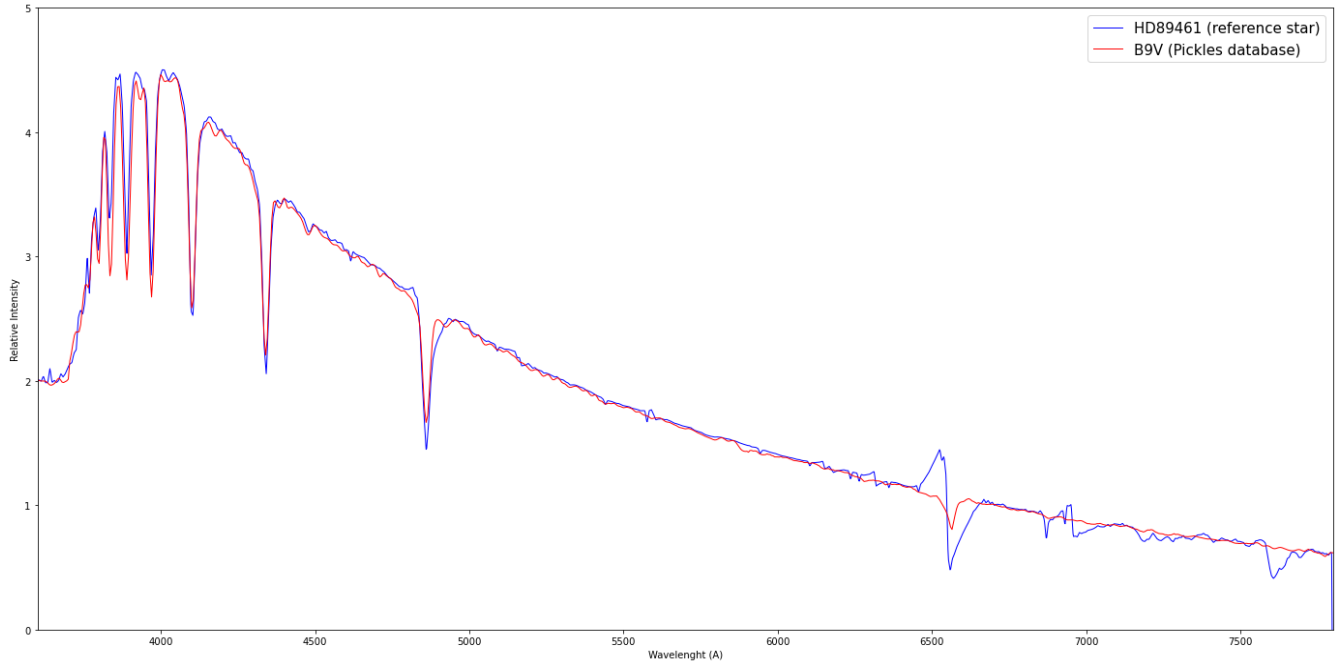

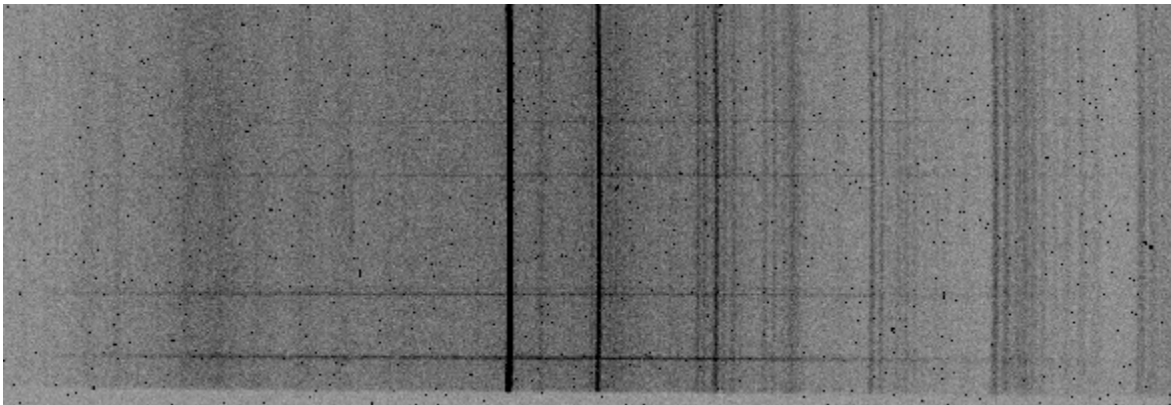

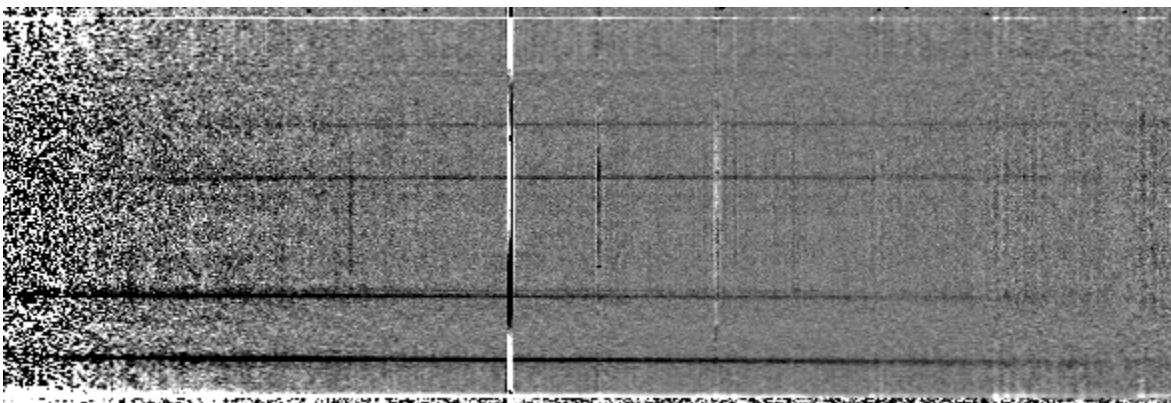
Instrumental response (red = theoretical ref star spectrum ; blue = acquired ref star spectrum with instrumental response correction applied)

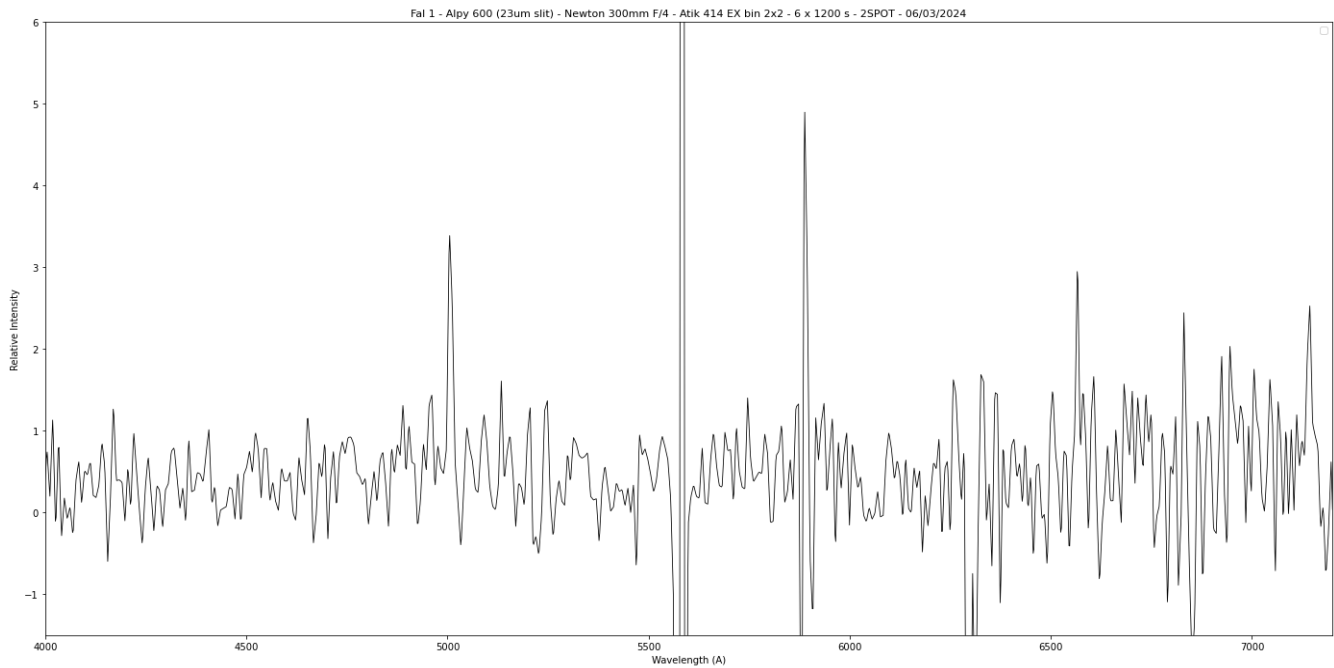


## 2D Raw spectrum
